## **Why must the Sandburg Primary Playground be replaced?**

**Approximately 500 of the youngest kids in our community are in need of safe and accessible equipment at the Sandburg Elementary primary playground.**

**We need your help to reach our goal of \$50,000 to build a playground that meets these important criteria:**

**Safety** - The current Sandburg Elementary primary playground equipment dates back several decades. Many parts of our playground are not up to safety standards and must be removed including slides, railings, cement bases, gravel and poor drainage.

**Accessibility** - Sandburg Elementary has made renovations within the school building to make it inclusive for children with physical disabilities. The current Sandburg primary playground is **NOT** accessible to children in wheelchairs or with other physical disabilities.

**Physical Well-being** - Students at Sandburg Elementary typically use the playground for 30 minutes a day, five times per week. Often, up to 100 children are playing on the playground at once. The school needs a larger and more stimulating playground to serve these children.
